

FUND-RAISING EVENTS

Council must establish rules for fund-raising in their campaign expenses and contributions by-law.

A “fund-raising event” is any social function held for the purpose of raising money for a registered candidate (e.g. dinners, dances, luncheons, and raffles). Fund-raising events held by or on behalf of a registered candidate must be held only during the campaign period.

If a registered candidate holds a fundraiser for their campaign, the candidate must record and apportion the revenues and expenses associated with the event in accordance with the municipality’s campaign expenses and contribution by-law.

No money shall be contributed anonymously into a general collection (pass the hat, arm’s length tickets, etc.) at a fund-raising event in excess of \$10.00. Contributions in excess of this amount are to be reported as individual contributions.
