The summer refuse schedule will begin April 1st, 2010 and will be in effect until October 31st, 2010 (subject to change).

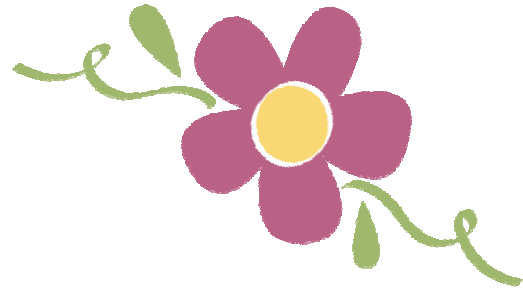
Tuesday – All residences that are **south** of Centre Street and the Vesturland area.

Thursday – All residences that are **north** of Centre Street.

Commercial Pickup – Monday, Wednesday & Friday

- ***Thanksgiving**, Monday, October 11th, 2010



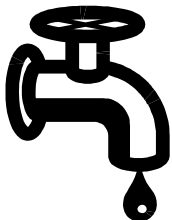
All commercial pick up scheduled for Monday will be picked up on Tuesday, pick up scheduled for Thursday will be picked up on Wednesday.

HAZARDOUS WASTE cannot be accepted at the Landfill Site and will be refused. These items can be taken to Miller Environmental Corporation, 1803 Hekla Avenue, Winnipeg, (204) 925-9600.

REFUSE COLLECTION

Always ensure your refuse is contained safely in garbage cans and put out by 8:00 am on the scheduled day. Some refuse containers have been identified as either posing danger to the refuse crew, or too heavy for pickup. Please review the state of your containers and make appropriate changes if required, otherwise your refuse will not be picked up.

SPRING CLEAN UP

All residents will receive a **Special Spring Cleanup of Compost Material**, which includes grass clippings, leaves and tree branches (as specified below*). Spring Clean up will begin on May 3rd and will continue through the month of May. Pick up will occur on a rotational basis throughout the municipality. **All compost material must be contained in clear plastic bags and separated from regular refuse during Spring Clean up and Regular Pick up.**

COMPOST PICK-UP & DISPOSAL SITE

Following the Spring Cleanup, only one bag of Compost Material, which includes grass clippings and leaves, will be picked-up with your regular garbage pickup. **Beginning May 22nd, compost material can be disposed at the Autumnwood Shop on Saturday & Sunday from 9am to 2pm.**

**Tree Branches, 2 inches or less in diameter, maximum 3 foot length, tied in bundles weighing no more than 40 pounds, will also be picked up with regular refuse pick up. The Arnes Landfill Site will accept branches, trees and unbundled brush larger than specified above, at no cost.*

E-WASTE

Beginning May 22nd, E-Waste can be disposed at the Autumnwood Shop on Saturday & Sunday, 9 am to 2 pm, or at the Arnes Landfill Site during regular operating hours, at no cost. The municipality then takes the E-Waste to Responsible Electronic Recycling in Selkirk. To help increase our efficiency you can take your E-Waste directly to Responsible Electronic Recycling, 511 Robinson, Selkirk, MB, Monday to Friday, 8:30am – 4:30pm.



USED OIL COLLECTION

The Municipality has two locations to receive this type of waste. They are located at the Arnes Landfill Site and Industrial Park Public Works Shop. The hours of acceptance at the Public Works Shop are Wednesday to Friday, 10:00 am to 3:00 pm. These locations only accept used oil (uncontaminated), oil containers, and oil filters. Public Works personnel **MUST** be present while disposing oil.

DUMP PASSES are required to dispose all garbage, other than e-waste, compost material and scrap metal, at the Arnes Landfill Site. \$15.00 passes (up to 1/2 ton truck load) can be purchased at the Municipal Office, Super A Foods and Tip Top Fine Foods. Demolition Waste and Tandem / Semi Truck loads are subject to a different fee amount. These passes can only be purchased at the Municipal Office, Monday to Friday, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.
